MUSIC THAT RESTORES - "LISTEN TO THE STREAM/XWELELAM TE STÓTEL $\bar{\rm O}$ "

On November 17, students from Imagine were the opening act for the BC Schools Superintendents Association annual meeting. Over a 20-minute presentation, our students shared three songs, a barrage of photo images, and a range of student voices sharing the work of environmental restoration they have been doing in local habitats.

The Stream Restoration project was a year-long undertaking engaged in by grade 10 students in Ms. Dempsey and Ms. Zeng's class last year. Throughout the year, students partnered with a variety of organizations as they worked to restore local habitats. As students learned about biodiversity, invasive species, and healthy ecosystems, they got to put that knowledge into practice by actually visiting wilderness spaces where they were able to remove invasive species, and re-plant indigenous species.

Reflecting on these experiences, students worked with the Good Medicine Songs group to create lyrics for a bilingual song (Halq'eméylem and English) about their work with local streams. These lyrics were then shared with the Imagine High Rock Band class, who added their own rock-band-flare to create the song "Listen to the Stream."

It was a collection of these students: choir members from the Stream Restoration program, and band members from Rock Band, who visited Vancouver on November 17 to share their experience. Our students performed with poise, and shared articulately before the 600-700 attendees of the conference. It was an inspiring and celebratory day that received an enthusiastic standing ovation.

Schulich Leaders- Nomination Deadline December 09, 2023

Schulich Leader Scholarships are Canada's most coveted undergraduate STEM scholarships. One hundred are awarded to entrepreneurial-minded high school graduates enrolling in a Science, Technology, Engineering or Math program at 20 partner universities across Canada. Half are valued at \$120,000 for engineering scholarships and half are valued at \$100,000* for science and math scholarships. COMMUNITY RESOURCE HIGHLIGHT: PACIFIC COMMUNITY RESOURCES SOCIETY (PCRS)
