

Inclusive Education Assistant

Dual-Credit

Inclusive EA training is offered to Grade-12 students with an interest in working with school-aged children and youth. Inclusive Education Assistants can support students with diverse abilities in elementary, middle, and high schools in a variety of settings, including regular classrooms, learning support rooms, work experience sites, or in life-training settings.

Students must be enrolled and completing English 12, and have completed English 11, Math 11, English 10 and Math 10 with C+ average to enroll in part-time studies at the *University of the Fraser Valley* in their Grade 12 year. Students must have the intention to graduate with a Dogwood diploma (B.C. Graduation Certificate).

Students will complete courses toward the Inclusive Education Assistant certificate. Tuition fees are covered by the School District. Ancillary fees, books and materials are the student's responsibility. Application process is competitive and space is limited.
